While we have had to wait a few extra months for the ground breaking of our building addition, the final plans have been submitted and we look forward to an early spring ground breaking. It will be exciting to have extra space for our children's and adult classes as well as an inviting space for community events. Our capital campaign is currently at 90% of the \$2 million needed. The total \$2 million can be split into four categories: \$922,411.70 has been given and most currently sits in an investment through Chase Bank until next spring. \$195,089.62 remains as committed but will be given over the next 24 months. \$565,300 is professional work in kind that has been committed. \$216,321.99.13 remains to be raised. Thank you for your sacrificial and generous commitments.
