The following Tuesday she did an intense workout that required a lot of upper body weight lifting. Her trainer told her to take it easy. She ignored him and kept working out. He noticed a swelling on her arm. Charlotte tried to brush him off, but she noticed that afternoon the swelling had increased. She went to the doctor and was diagnosed with rhabdomyolysis, a life-threatening condition where muscle overuse causes kidney failure. As they gave her IV fluids to flush out the toxins, her doctor told her that if she'd waited even another 30 minutes, they would have been having this discussion in the emergency room.
