

Greetings Campion Church Family,

I want to update you halfway through this year on our church finances. Last December, the Church took a leap of faith and voted a budget for 2015 of just over \$194,000 for the year, the largest budget seen in my time at Campion. Approval of this budget represented an investment in our church and a commitment to provide full time office support to our pastoral team and an increase in the ministries supported through church budget. We have certainly been blessed this year in many areas of Church finance. Giving to student financial aid for both HMS and Campion has been outstanding – nearly \$20,000 in giving! Many other areas of ministry have also been blessed with financial gifts and, in turn, our Church Family is reaping the rewards.

Our monthly operating budget at the church is \$16,200 and this provides for the infrastructure of the church. Insurance, heating, air conditioning, cleaning services, and many of the other "behind the scenes" functions we've come to enjoy at the church are provided for through the Church budget. We have completed seven months of our budget year and are currently \$21,000 behind in church budget giving. Twice each month the offering goes to the cover the local church expense and the other two times goes to provide funds for world missions, higher education, and conference evangelism. These are all important to the ultimate work of sharing the gospel! I know God had great plans for our Church and together, as a family, we will make an impact for heaven. As you plan your giving for the remainder of the year, please keep our Church budget in your prayers and part of your giving.
