On December 1, 1930, W.K. Kellogg replaced the three daily eight-hour shifts with four six-hour shifts. By adding an extra shift he was able to give more people work (as the great depression had started). In 1932 the U.S. Department of Labor sent a research team to Battle Creek to find out the impact. It had as suspected given more people work. But the research team discovered that those who were now only working six hours (Kellogg still paid them for 8 hours) described their lives with two words - family and freedom. Those are the two words that seem to come to God's mind when He thinks about the Sabbath. Welcome to Campion.
